FIREWORKS

Township of Tiny fireworks bylaws to all Owners. Please advise your Guests and Renters, These Rules.

Any exceptions, the By Law Dept will be called and you will be assessed a penalty.

- 3.1 No person shall hold a display of or set off consumer fireworks on any day or days during the year except on Victoria Day, Canada Day and the five days immediately preceding and/or following each of these days, or on New Year's Eve and New Year's Day.
- 3.2 Notwithstanding Section 3.1, a person may hold a display of or set off consumer fireworks on any day or days during the year where approval has been obtained from the Chief Fire Official.
- 3.10 No person shall set off any consumer fireworks on or into any park, parkette, trail, linear park, land used for storm water management, square, other public place or any land owned by the Township or any of their boards or agencies, without first having obtained permission from the Chief Fire Official, Manager of Public Works, or designate and the Recreation Coordinator, or designate.

9. PENALTY

9.1 Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to fine as provided for in the Municipal Act, 2001,
